Many of you will know that the legendary 1959 Fiesta Red Fender Stratocaster Serial Number 34346 purchased & imported by Cliff Richard for Hank Marvin is now owned by Bruce Welch. A few years ago a limited number of exact copies of this guitar were produced by the Fender Custom Shop in California. Naturally, all of these were right handed guitars, which was quite a problem for our good friend John Bell, who is a left handed player. Following some protracted negotiations John is now the very proud owner of the only 34346 specification Left Handed Fender Stratocaster Serial Number 1/1 in the world produced for him by Fender. 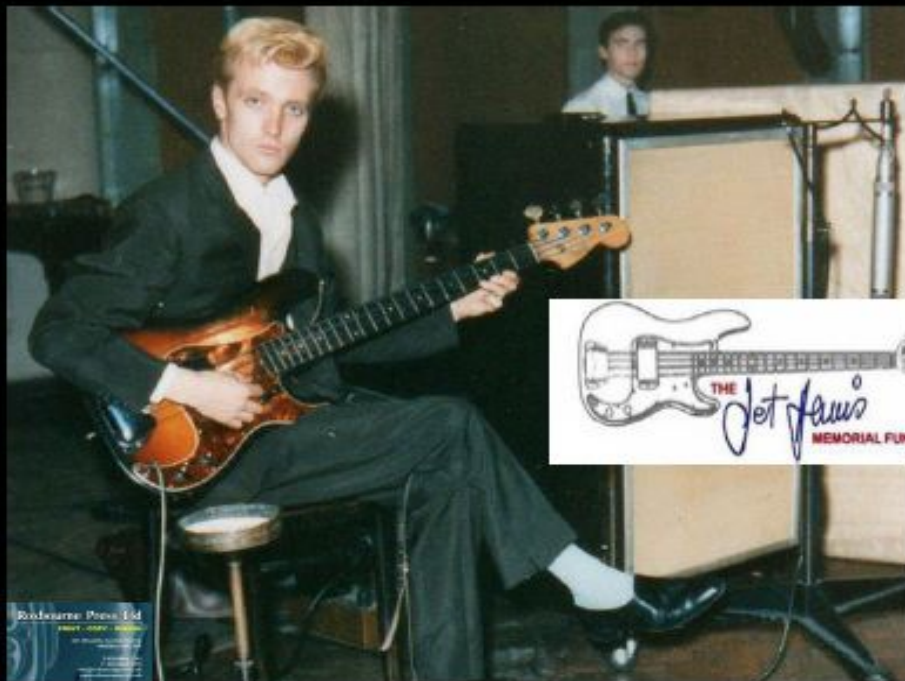

The legendary Jet Harris was born on 6 July, 1939 and was the first person in the UK to play an electric bass guitar in a band. He was the original bass player in Cliff Richard's backing group The Shadows and, in fact, it was Jet who thought up the name for the group. Jet appeared on many No.1 hit recordings, both backing Cliff Richard and also with The Shadows in their own right. After leaving The Shadows he had more hits on his own and with Tony Meehan, including their number one recording Diamonds. Jet continued to perform successfully until five weeks before his death on 18 March 2011, following a courageous two year battle against cancer of unknown primary. Jet's partner, Janet Hemingway, and close friends decided to create a fund in memory of Jet.
