I have decided to move on my Meazzi echoes while they are at their best. Both have been completely re-capped and run very quietly as a result. First is an all tube echomatic, the heads have been re-shuffled to give a nice Shadows type echo.

Second is an all transistor Factotum with the P.A. amps removed and the case re-modeled to make it just an echo.

Heads also re-shuffled for a Shads type echo, this produces a sound indistinguishable in my opinion from the valve model and I was quite surprised to hear it after it was rebuilt. Any interested parties will be sent pictures on request.

These echoes speak for themselves and are getting rarer by the day.
